The feedback survey will be web-based and include (at most) 29 questions. Respondents will take approximately 20 minutes to complete the survey through Survey Monkey. This estimate is based on piloting the survey with five CDC staff. For the 2017 Science Ambassador Fellowship summer course, we are seeking approval to collect feedback from 30 non-federal individuals (i.e., middle school, high school, and community college teachers). Given 30 respondents with a response time of 20 minutes each, the total response burden will be 10 hours. There will be no direct costs to the respondents other than their time to respond to the survey.
