

Nonmaterial/non-substantive change to an OMB approved information collection

Four non-substantive changes are requested to 201408-0920-1058, the Clinic Context Matters Study

- 1) Change in the number of clinician respondents due to the addition of a second study clinic in a different part of Chicago to increase the racial/ethnic diversity of the clinic population. This results in 5 clinics rather than the original 4. Therefore the total annual number of clinicians surveyed increases from 175 to 200.
- 2) Change in the study sites because 2 of the original clinics (in Newark and Houston) did not provide PrEP (the clinical intervention being studied) and they were replaced by clinics in 2 new cities (Washington DC and Jackson MS).
- 3) The total annual burden hours would increase from 88 to 100.
- 4) Minor change to interview form to change clinic site of clinician respondent.
