

About this Survey

We are conducting this survey to get a picture of how Americans spend their money and how the percentages devoted to different spending categories change over time.

With Consumer Expenditure (CE) data, users can:

- Understand changes in housing costs as a percentage of the average American household's income.
- Compare transportation costs for young, middle-aged, and older households.
- Understand changes in health insurance costs for the average American household.

The CE data are also used to update the "market basket" of goods and services for the Consumer Price Index (CPI).
