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Request a Waiver/Authorization

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Request a Waiver/Airspace Authorization Small Unmanned Aircraft System (sUAS)

14 CFR part 107 includes numerous provisions from which a proponent can request a waiver or airspace authorization. A request for a waiver, airspace authorization, or a combination of both may be submitted through this web page. The proponent should fully understand part 107 prior to requesting a waiver or airspace authorization. This page includes numerous links to background information related to this process and we encourage proponents to fully review this information.

When ready, please review the entire form and the information being requested. We recommend you gather and organize your information prior to completing the form. Please provide all the required information requested. The FAA will review your request to determine whether the proposed operations can be conducted safely and if so, issue a certificate of waiver or certificate of airspace authorization (for 14 CFR 107.41 airspace authorizations only).

You can request waiver from sections of part 107 that are waivable. Section 107.41 in particular is subject to ATC authorization. In other words, if you can comply with all of part 107 (without needing a waiver) but request to operate within certain controlled airspace, then you should request an airspace authorization only, per section 107.41.

The form for submitting a request for a waiver or airspace authorization under 14 CFR part 107, subpart D, is a collection of information under the Paperwork Reduction Act of 1995. The Federal Aviation Administration will use the information you provide in response to the following questions to regulate and promote safety in air commerce, in accordance with its statutory authority, 49 USC § 44701; see also FAA Modernization and Reform Act of 2012, Pub. L. 112-95 § 333, Special Rules for Certain Unmanned Aircraft Systems. This information collection will take approximately 45 minutes to complete. You are not required to respond to this collection of information unless it displays a valid OMB control
