- Revised! 30 have proposed changes to already existing categories, and were revised prior to the 30 day comment period based on feedback from the 60 day comment period and/or technical edits and corrections.
- **Revised! 60** were revised prior to the 60 day comment period.
- **Retired!** are no longer being collected in SYs 2017-18 and 2018-19, under the ESEA, as amended by ESSA.
- **Final!** have been revised in the final package in response to the 30 day public comment feedback received and decisions not to implement ESSA regulations.
