The application window for current high school seniors and juniors is open. The deadline for seniors to complete their applications is the 28th of February. If you are a current high school junior and interested in applying to West Point visit our Summer Program for more information.for more information.

- 1. Are you eligible to apply for admission to West Point? Eligible means meeting the basic requirements:
  - · At least 17 but not yet 23 years of age (i.e. if you are applying for the Class of 2021 your Date-of-Birth (DOB) cannot be after 6/30/2000)
  - Not married
  - Not pregnant or have a legal obligation to support a child
  - · A U.S. citizen (exception: see International Admissions)

If you are eligible, fill out and submit the initial screening application, called the Candidate Questionnaire.

2. Then, if you are approved to proceed, you receive access to your online Candidate Kit. It contains additional forms and instructions for completing your application.
