ONE CALL DOES IT ALL!

To report a hazardous condition at a mine to MSHA, call: **1-800-746-1553**
or use the [on-line filing option](#) (For more information, see below).

You do not need to identify yourself!

To report an *imminent danger hazardous condition* call: **1-800-746-1553**
(a condition that could cause a serious accident, injury, illness or fatality)

For the *Mine Maps Hotline, Impoundments Hotline, and Abandoned Mines* call: **1-800-746-1553**

Submit a Hazardous Condition Complaint

There are two ways to submit a Hazardous Condition Complaint. You may either use the phone or our on-line filing option. Either way, **you do not need to identify yourself!**

When reporting, please provide as much of the following information you can. It will help us to help you.

- Name of company
- Name of mine
- Location of mine (city/town)
- State where mine is located
- If you know the **MSHA ID** for the mine, please include it. You may search for an MSHA ID by either mine name or company name using MSHA's [Mine Data Retrieval System \(MDRS\)](#).

To submit a complaint **by phone**, please dial **1-800-746-1553**.

To submit a complaint **on-line**, please **use the button to the right**. This will take you to our on-line filing application for reporting hazardous conditions at mine sites only. It is not to be used for any other purpose.
