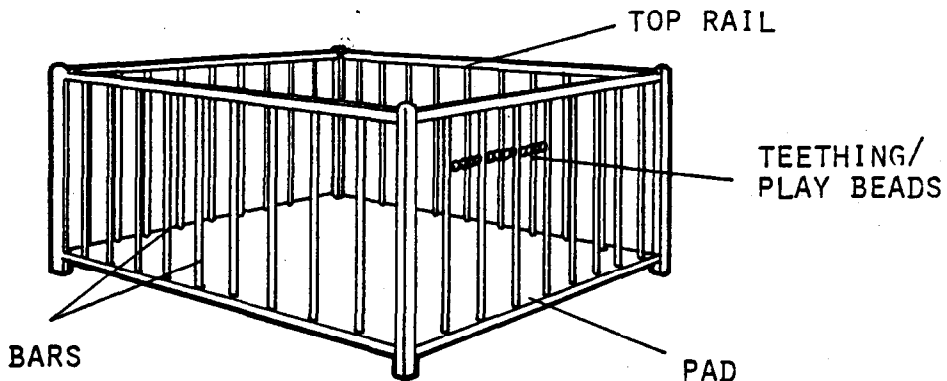
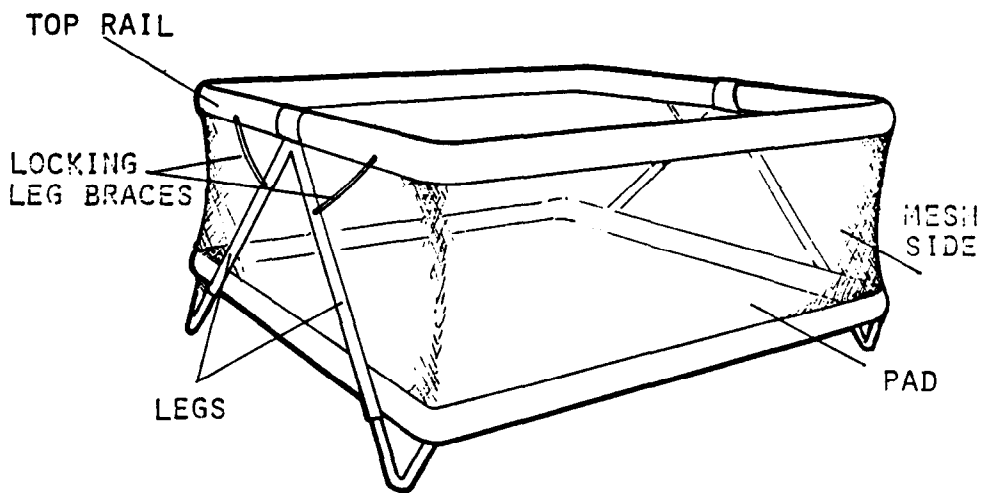

# HAZARD PATTERNS

## PLAYPENS

A

Chewing playpens: Child chews soft plastic edge or parts of playpen and chokes on piece removed.



B

Product failure: Part of playpen breaks, wears out or is constructed in such a way to cause hazard.



C

Cut on sharp edge: Child playing normally or trying to 'escape' cuts self on sharp edge.



D

Interference: Victim is pushed or pulled into playpen or person closing playpen is unaware that child will be trapped by closure.
