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Elicitation Interview Protocol

Information Type	Elicitation Question
Experiential Attitude	1. How do you feel about black lung screenings? 2. What do you like or dislike about them? 3. How do you feel about mandatory black lung screenings?
Instrumental Attitude	4. What are the benefits of getting screened for black lung? 5. What are the disadvantages or issues with getting screened for black lung?
Normative Influence	6. Who would support you in getting screened for black lung? 7. Who would be against you getting screened for black lung?
Perceived Control	8. What makes or would make it easy for you to get screened? 9. What makes or would make it hard to get screened?
Self-Efficacy	10. If you wanted to go get screened, how certain are you that you could? 11. What would help you overcome any barriers to getting screened for black lung?
