If you do not currently have TPS, DHS will use the information you provide to grant or deny the benefit you are seeking. If you have TPS and are filing for re-registration, DHS will use the information provided to determine whether you are continuing to maintain TPS eligibility or whether to deny your TPS re-registration and withdraw your existing TPS.

ROUTINE USES: Consistent with TPS confidentiality requirements in 8 CFR Section 244.16 and other relevant legal authorities, DHS may share the information you provide on this benefit form, including supporting documentation you provide, with other Federal, state, local, and foreign government agencies and authorized organizations.
