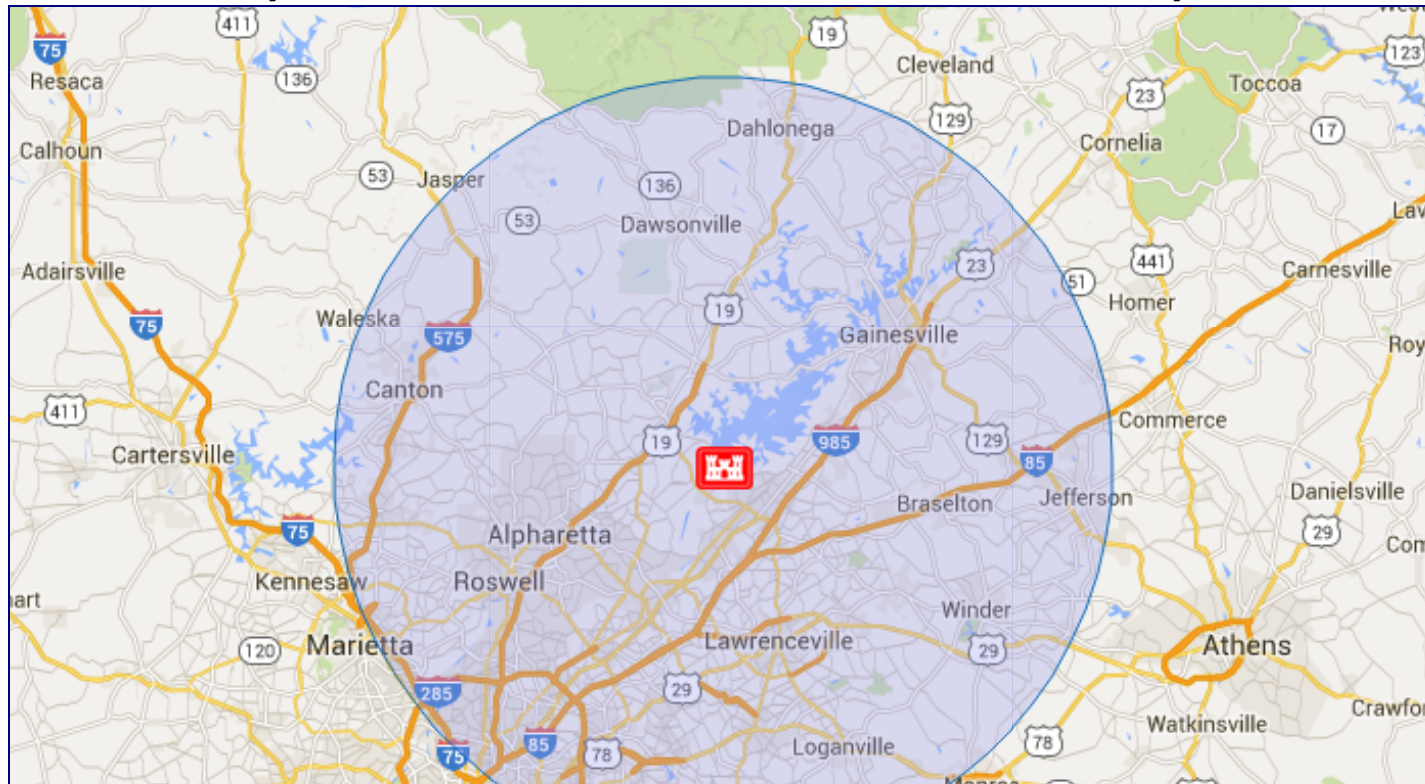
The map below shows a 30-mile radius around **Lake Sidney Lanier**. For the purposes of this survey, the area that is shaded area is the *local area*.

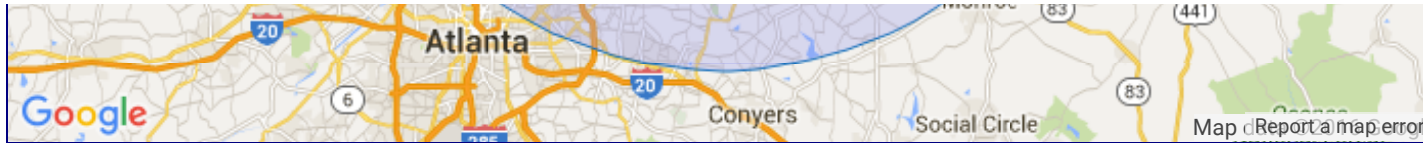


Lake Sidney Lanier

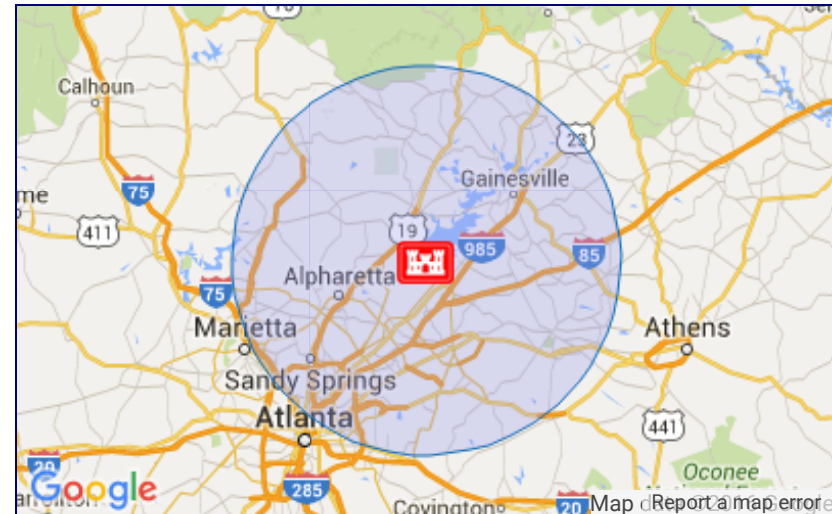

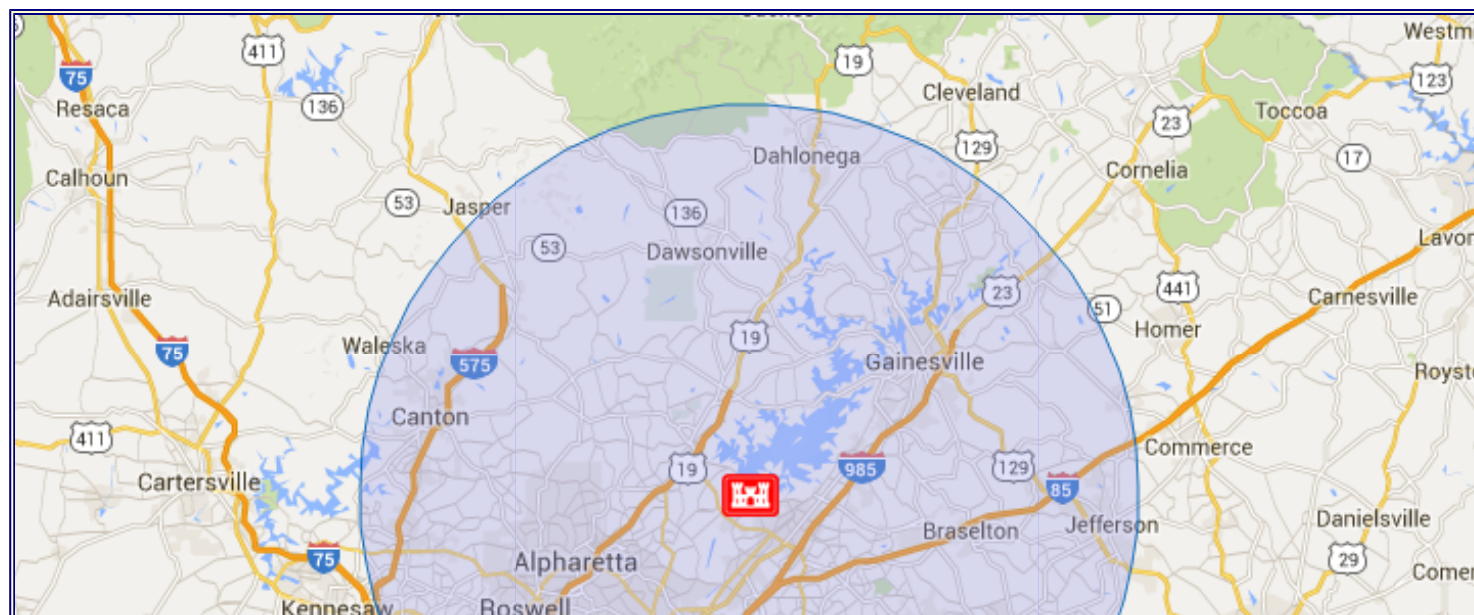

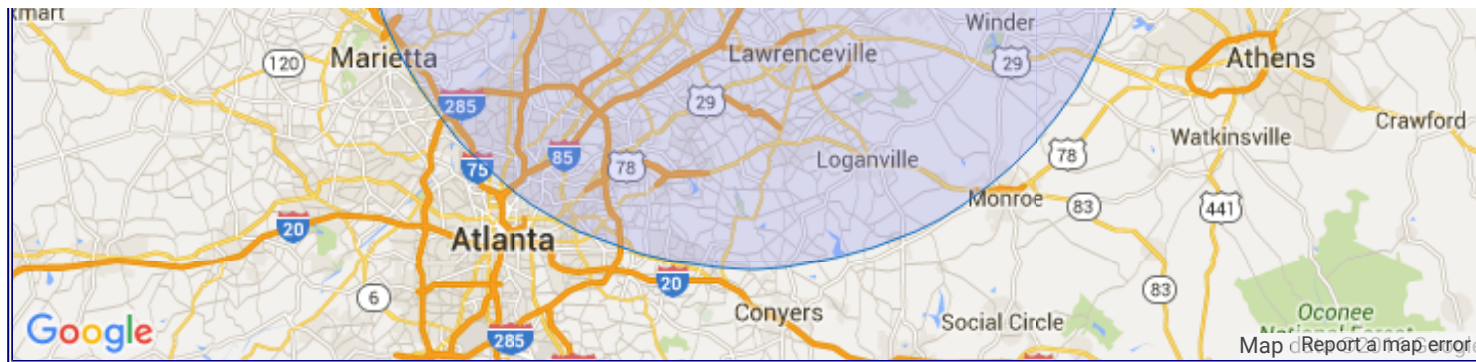
