The Occupational Outlook Handbook (OOH) is the Government's primary source for detailed career information and employment projections for hundreds of occupations in the United States.

The Bureau of Labor Statistics (BLS) currently updates the OOH occupation profiles with new information and employment projections every 2 years.

In addition, other information in the *OOH* will be updated in "real-time," rather than once every two years.
