## **MA-100A PRODUCER WEIGHT RECORD BULK FARM TANK TICKET**

The following changes will be made when the lab orders new MA-100 Pink Tickets.

- 1) The words: "Form Approved, OMB 0581-0032" in the upper right hand corner of the front page of the form; and
- 2) The Burden and Non-discrimination Statements will appear on the reverse side of the form. These paragraphs will be in no smaller than font size 8. The following are the current Burden and Non-discrimination Statements:
