Attachment 12: Data Collector Non-Disclosure Agreement

To protect participant privacy and to foster an atmosphere of respect for participants, it is important that all persons who are involved in data collection for the Assessment of Targeted Training and Technical Assistance (TTA) Efforts on the Implementation of Comprehensive Cancer Control project accept the following in respect to participants' privacy:

- Data collectors may only share information gained through data collection efforts related to this evaluation with other members of the project team.

Data collectors are not to use the collected data for any purpose other than the work associated with this research project and will not include individual identifying information in any reports or subsequent publications.
