TITLE OF INFORMATION COLLECTION: 2019 American Community Survey (ACS) Due Date Test Experiment Cognitive Interviews

PURPOSE: There has been evidence from previous studies that using a due date can create a sense of urgency and compliance. To test if due dates will help increase the ACS response rates the Census Bureau developed alternative ACS mailing materials for the 2019 American Community Survey (ACS) Due Date Test Experiment. The purpose of this cognitive research is to evaluate whether revisions made to the ACS mail materials are effective at communicating that there is a due date and what will happen if a respondent does not respond by the listed due date.

Respondents will be recruited through fliers posted at local community organizations, advertisements on Craigslist.com, and broadcast messages distributed through the Census Bureau's daily online newsletter. All recruiting materials are attached (see Enclosure 3). Our recruiting efforts will target respondents who are most likely to handle the mail and react to it in a household. We will recruit respondents who read at different literacy levels, using education as a proxy measure. We will also recruit respondents with diverse demographic characteristics and household composition to the maximum extent possible.
