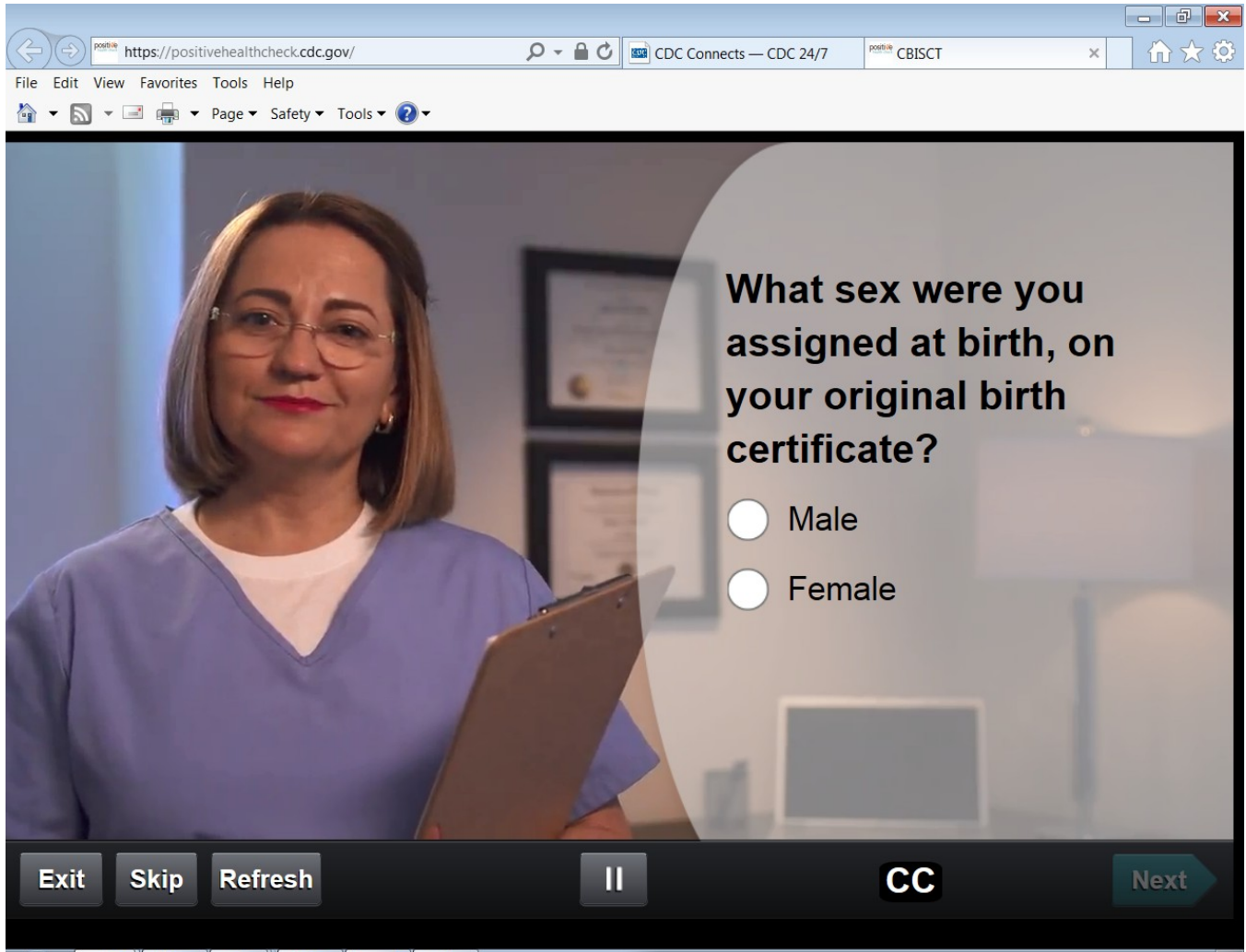


Positive Health Check is a service mark of the U.S. Department of Health & Human Services (HHS).
