TITLE OF INFORMATION COLLECTION:

Feedback Survey on IES FY 2020 Request for Applications (RFAs)

PURPOSE:

Through its discretionary research grants programs, the Institute of Education Sciences (IES) seeks to improve the quality of education for all students through research advancing the understanding of and practices for teaching, learning, and organizing education systems. During the Spring of 2019, the National Center for Education Research (NCER) and the National Center for Special Education Research (NCSEER) within IES released Requests for Applications (RFAs) for discretionary grant funding in FY 2020. IES revised the FY 2020 RFAs to make it clearer, shorter, less restrictive, and accessible to a wider range of potential applicants. As part of the revisions, IES also released new RFAs for the Research Grants Focused on Systematic Replication (84.305R) and Research Grants Focused on Systematic Replication in Special Education (84.324R) programs.

The purpose of the attached surveys is to obtain feedback on the success of the revisions to the RFAs and whether further changes are necessary.
