However, this list may also contain email addresses of individuals who are otherwise associated with permit or notice holders, such as private consultants and attorneys. TTB will examine the overall list and any duplicate email addresses will be removed.

Once the list of email addresses is perfected, we plan to send an email survey invitation to all email addresses on the list. The invitation will contain a direct link to the survey, which will be hosted by SurveyMonkey, an external website. The survey will be open for one month. Halfway through that month, a second, follow up email will be sent reminding the invitees to take the survey. At the end of the one month time period or once we reach a total of 5,000 respondents, whichever comes first, we will stop administering the survey and compile the results.
