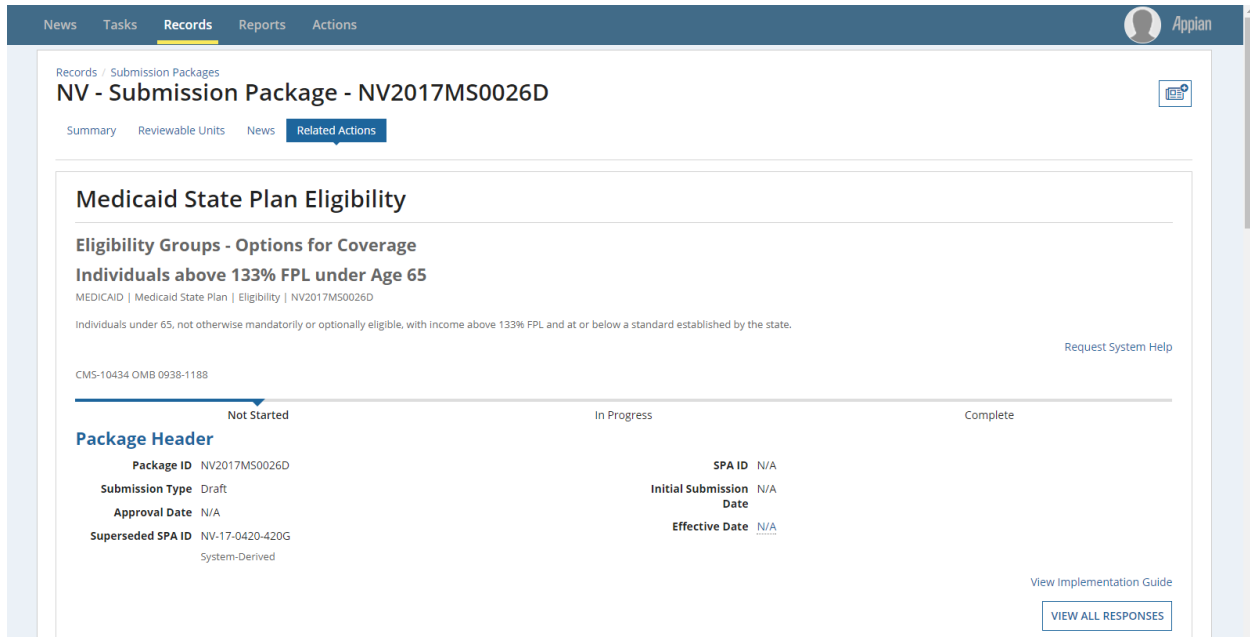


Figure 1: Package Header

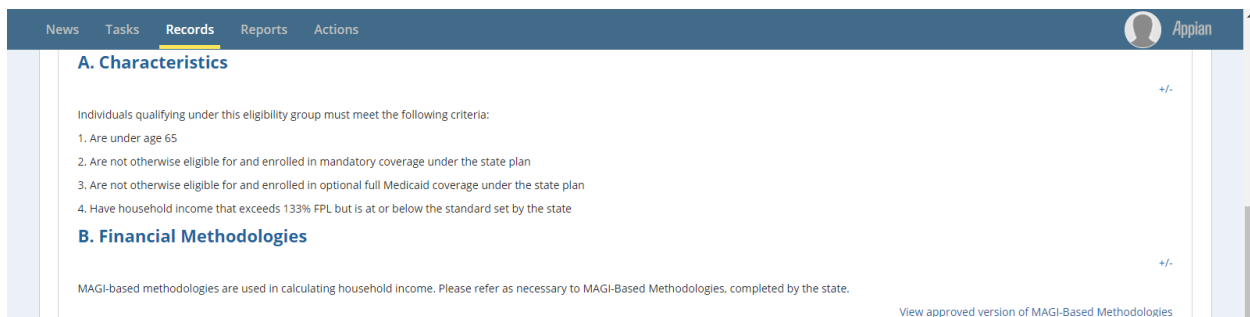


Figure 2: Section A and Section B
