


Figure 2: Measurement Specification - Path 1




Figure 3: Measurement Specification – Path 2




Figure 4: Data Source




Figure 8: Optional Measure Stratification – Screenshot 1 of 2




Figure 9: Optional Measure Stratification - Screenshot 2 of 2
