The above Average Hourly Wage Rate is the <u>May 2017 Bureau of Labor Statistics</u> average wage for "All Occupations" of \$24.34 times the wage rate benefit multiplier of 1.4 (to account for fringe benefits) equaling \$34.08. The selection of "All Occupations" (for example) was chosen as the expected respondents for this collection could be expected to be from any occupation.

FEDERAL COST: The estimated annual cost to the Federal government is \$1,568.32

It is estimated that 1 government employee at a GS level 14, Step 1 will spending approximately 1% of their time (2080 annual working hours x 1% = 20.8 hours) annually to review, analyze, and assimilate survey responses.

Using the FY17 (Washington-Baltimore-Northern Virginia) GS pay scale, the fully-loaded wage rate for a GS14, Step 1 is \$ 75.40 (\$ 112,021 annual salary/2080 = \$53.86 base wage rate x 1.4 benefit multiplier = \$75.40 fully-loaded wage rate).

The annual government cost is estimated to be \$ 1,568.32 (20.8 hours annually x \$75.40 = \$ 1,568.32).
