PURPOSE: The purpose of this information collection effort is to obtain the current level of satisfaction student veterinarians have with USDA student veterinary incentive programs. We also seek to use recommendations from these surveys to improve programs offered to veterinary students by USDA/ Food Safety Inspection Service (FSIS) and other federal agencies that employ a large number of Public Health Veterinarians.

## **DESCRIPTION OF RESPONDENTS:**

FSIS will provide a link to this collection effort to all veterinary students in their monthly newsletter. Students eligible to complete this survey must be at least eighteen years of age, and enrolled in an accredited US veterinary program. There are presently 30 colleges in the U.S. that offer accredited veterinary programs, each program has approximately 100 graduating student Veterinarians per year. Since veterinary school is 4 years, we predict the newsletter will reach approximately 12,000 veterinary students. Students will have no obligation to provide their feedback, but all students will have the opportunity should they elect to do so. Though the newsletter will be sent to all applicable colleges, we predict a low response rate of approximately, 100-1000 students. FSIS will use the feedback from this survey to design programs that best meet the needs of future veterinary graduates.
