Talkback Board Questions (whiteboard with Post-Its, free form responses):

2. Who can be an American diplomat?
3. What adjectives would you use to describe American diplomats and their work?

Before and After Questions:

1. How possible is it for you or someone like you to become a diplomat? Scale 1-10 (10 is very possible)
2. How relevant is American diplomacy to your life in some way? Scale 1-10 (10 is very relevant)
3. How interested would you be interested in attending this exhibit when it opens? Scale 1-10 (10 is very interested)

Free Form Questions:

1. What part of the exhibit do you enjoy the most? Why?
2. What would you change about this exhibit?
3. How would you describe the exhibit to a friend?
