Instructions

This document provides general instructions for using the PRC Program Evaluation Reporting System (PRC-PERS), including an overview of its layout and contents, as well as instructions for data entry.

PRC-PERS starts with the OMB Compliance Statement, these instructions, support information, and radio buttons to select which budget year you will report (e.g., Budget Year 4). You can choose to enter data throughout the reporting period, or once annually, until the deadline provided by the PRC Program.

The **Records Home Page** includes a legend of status icons that reflect the status you have selected for the fields you have entered, and a table of the sections of the Data Collection Instrument. These status icons reflect REDCap system prompts at the end of each data entry section. Selection of one of four "status" options will result in the status button colors changing on the Records Home Page according to these definitions:

REDCap System Prompts:

Form Status: Status of the selected record - Options include:

Blank - white status icon - default status - No data has been entered for the selected record

Incomplete - Red icon status - staff at PRC select Incomplete when they have not completed data entry for the selected record

Unverified - Yellow status icon - staff at PRC select Unverified if they have not verified or quality checked their data entry - selecting Unverified could remind the PRC staff to confirm something prior to marking the record Complete.

Complete - Green status icon - staff at PRC select Complete to indicate data entry for the selected record is complete and verified

Save & Exit Form - Save any changes made to the selected record, and return to the Record Home Page.

Save & Stay - Save any changes made to the selected record, and stay on the current data collection page.

Cancel - Cancel any changes made to the selected record, and return to the Record Home Page.

Each section of the instrument will have section specific instructions and definitions when applicable.

Data collection begins with Partnerships. At the top of this section and at the top of every data collection section, there are built in REDCap user features. These include:
