The program requires that any state that administers its own installation program, submit an application to have its program reviewed and qualified by the Department to ensure that its program meets or exceeds the Federal standards. All other states that does not have an installation program or chooses not to administer an installation program is considered a HUD-administered installation state.				
The program requires that an installer in a HUD administered state apply for a Federal installer license and after completing the installation of a home, have the home inspected by a qualified inspector outlined in the regulations. The program also requires that any retailer who sells a home into a HUD-administered state submit forms to track the sale and location of the home. The HUD Forms-305, 306, 307, 308, 309, and 312 used in this program allows the department to document and track the requirements of the program.
