## Justification for Non-Substantive Changes for Form SSA-8202 Statement for Determining Continuing Eligibility for Supplemental Security Income Payment 20 CFR 416.204 OMB No. 0960-0145

## **Background**

The agency uses Form SSA-8202 (Statement for Determining Continuing Eligibility for Supplemental Security Income Payment) to review a recipient or couple's non-medical eligibility factors (i.e., income, resources, and living arrangements) to determine whether the recipient or couple is still eligible for and receiving the correct Supplemental Security Income payment.

## **Revision to Form SSA-8202:**

- **Change #1:** We are revising the language on Page 3 Question 8A.
  - O **Current Language:** Do you, or your spouse living with you, have any checking, or savings accounts, or any other funds in the bank? Include any accounts where you have direct deposit of any money.
  - O **New Language:** Do you, or your spouse living with you, have any checking, savings or Achieving A Better Life (ABLE) accounts, or any other funds in the bank? Include any accounts where you have direct deposit or any money."

**Justification #1:** We made the revision to align with the ABLE question that the agency added to the SSI claims system.

SSA will implement the changes to the SSA-8202 upon OMB approval.
