lete Part 2. This form requests specific details about the scope and burden of the information that you will be ting. Your ICR may have several Part 2 forms to cover specific types of Information Collections (ICs). At minimum, the n on different categories of respondents (i.e. Private sector, Individuals, State/Local/Tribal governments) must be d into individual Part 2 IC forms. However, you may choose or need to break down your ICR burden further in order arly characterize different types of response.

Consult RegInfo.gov to see how many ICs were used previously (if renewing or revising an ICR). Create as many copies of the blank Part 2 worksheet as needed before starting. (To do this, right-click on the "Part 2" tab, select "Move or Copy", then check the "Create a copy" box before hitting "OK".)

Fill out the Part 2 IC form with information from your Supporting Statement. You may also reference RegInfo.gov to copy over information that will not be changing from your previous approved ICR.


