#### **COST BURDEN TO RESPONDENTS:**

It is estimated that it will take respondents 5 minutes to complete the survey. The average hourly rate for a KSC contractor is  $$41.00 \times 833 \text{ hours} = $34,153.^{1}$  The average hourly rate for a KSC civil servant is  $$54.12 \times 167 \text{ hours} = $9,038.04^{2}$ . The total annual cost burden for all respondents will be \$43,191.04.

#### **FEDERAL COST:**

The estimated annual cost to the Federal government to process the information received is \$1,138.25 for administrative activities associated with conducting the survey, including compiling the list of customers and reporting. The average hourly wage for a GS-12, step 9 civil servant at Kennedy Space Center is \$45.53. The annual labor costs is a calculation that consists of the hourly wage of  $\$45.53 \times 25$  hours of labor.
