PSD Form 1200**

Form PSD 1200 is used by a market agency selling livestock on a commission basis as required, to provide information to the Packers and Stockyards Division (PSD) when the facility used for selling livestock meets the definition of a stockyard in Section 302 of the Packers and Stockyards Act, 1921, as amended and supplemented (7 U.S.C. 202) and, therefore, needs to be posted.
