Explantiaon of Revisions

1. During the previous 3 years of data collection for the HIV Outpatient Study, public health research has identified additional risk behaviors and factors potentially associated with the care and treatment of HIV positive persons such as the use of e-cigarettes and smokeless tobacco, opioids, medical marijuana, Pre-exposure Prophylaxis and mental health related issues. Twelve additional survey questions (**Attachment 9**) are being added to further assess these additional risk behaviors and factors among HIV positive patients participating in the HIV Outpatient Study and there potential effect on their HIV care and treatment. Based on review of the current survey response items and the average completion time, these new questions will not pose additional burden on participants.
