The study involves a virtual interview that should take about an hour of your time, followed by a short questionnaire. In total, the study will take about 90 minutes or less of your time.

The interview is done using Zoom, an Internet-based video conference platform. If you qualify to take part in the study, we will give you an Internet link that connects you to your interview. We can give you a WIFI on-demand pass that gives you temporary Internet access for the interview, or you can also choose to use your own Internet. Your own phone, tablet or laptop will be required to connect to the interview. While you and the person conducting the interview will be able to see one another, only audio information from the interview is recorded and saved.

I have a few questions for you to make sure you qualify for the study. All of your answers to these questions are voluntary.
