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Circumstances of Change Request for OMB 0920-0900

The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), Division of Global Migration and Quarantine (DGMQ) requests a nonmaterial/non-substantive of the currently approved Information Collection Request: "Contact Investigation Outcome Reporting Forms".

CDC is making minor changes in verbiage to the questions posed to cruise ship medical staff concerning outbreaks of influenza like illness (ILI) or influenza. The changes in verbiage are intended to clarify the intent of the question and be easier for the medical staff to answer. The changes are not expected to have any impact on reporting burden.

Description of the changes

Burden
