FY 2018 SLFS FILE SUBMISSION INSTRUCTIONS

FTP (File Transfer Protocol) - Send a File Utility

This is a user-friendly method of sending your data files to the Census Bureau.

1. Go to the URL: <https://secure.census.gov/cgi-bin/sendfile>
2. When prompted, login with your User-ID and Password. (User-ID = **govselfsec**; the Password will arrive in a separate e-mail.)
3. Browse to the file to be uploaded.
4. Select the file to be uploaded in the directory browser pop-up.
5. Click “Open” button in the directory browser pop-up. This closes the pop up, and places the file name (and its full path) in the text field labeled “File to Send.”
6. Optionally, provide a different name in the “New File Name” text field. This new name will be used to save the file on the target server.
7. Provide sender’s email address in the text field labeled “Sender’s Email Address.”
8. Please enter erd.f33.list@census.gov in the text field “Census Bureau Employee’s E-Mail Address.” An e-mail will be sent to this e-mail address when the upload process is complete letting staff know your data have been uploaded to the Census Bureau.
