3. A recommendation letter from your highest-ranking official showing the organization's support of your participation in the program
4. A list of key competitors (in order that we may avoid creating a cohort that would be unable to share effectively due to competitive situations)

Selection decisions will be based on (1) sector mix, (2) appropriate level within the organization, (3) likelihood to follow through, (4) diversity, and (5) no direct competitors with participating award recipients or other Fellows. Candidates will be notified of the decision by January 31, 2019. Tuition payment of \$28,000 is due by February 27, 2019. The fee covers all materials, as well as a standard hotel room and at least four meals for each session.
