Information Statement

This version of a training plan is an optional format based on the mandatory requirements under 30 CFR Part 46 for mine operators and contractors. The training plan contains information pertaining to the training of miners that is needed to prevent or reduce the number of accidents, injuries, illnesses and, ultimately, fatalities in the Nations mines.
