As in previous iterations of NIS, interviews will be conducted using a **laptop computer** in all participating jurisdictions, and these laptops **are approved** for use in each of the above facilities. An internet connection is not needed to conduct the survey, and Wi-Fi has been disabled on all study laptops. RTI is aware a facility may prohibit the use of computer equipment with extremely high-risk inmates, and those decisions will be made on a case-by-case basis.

RTI would like to offer inmates a small **incentive** for their participation in the NIS-4.
