Participation in this study is voluntary. You can skip any survey or interview question and stop the interview at any time. Stopping the interview or choosing not to participate will have no impact on your SNAP benefits.

The interview will occur during the weeks of March 4<sup>th</sup> and March 11<sup>th</sup> in Oakland. Participants will receive \$40 in cash for an in-person interview to offset any costs such as childcare or traveling that you may have incurred by your participation.
