Privacy Act Notice

- **Authority:** 46 U.S.C 6102 and 33 CFR 174 authorize the collection of information on boating accidents.
- **Purpose:** The Coast Guard uses the information for statistical purposes, chiefly to inform the public, to measure the Program's efforts, and to regulate issues relating to boating safety.
- **Routine Use:** The Coast Guard shares this information within the agency, and if state and federal law permit it, to the public.
- **Disclosure:** Some information may not be required to be reported under federal regulation. Questions relating to the collection of this data should be sent to the Coast Guard.
