Minor Revisions to the Collection

SSA is making the following revisions:

- **Change #1:** We are revising the Privacy Act Statement on this form.

Justification #1: SSA's Office of the General Counsel is conducting a systematic review of SSA's Privacy Act Statements on agency forms. As a result, SSA is updating the Privacy Act Statement on the form.

- **Change #2:** We are revising the PRA statement on this form.

Justification #2: We are revising the PRA statement to reflect our current boilerplate language. The current language, which dates back to the last reprint of the form, is now outdated.

- **Change #3:** We are updating the burden information for this collection.

Justification #3: Due to legislative changes we are implementing because of Section 102 of the Strengthening Protections for Social Security Benefits Act of 2018 (Pub.L. 115-165), we are significantly reducing the burden for this form. Section 102 of Pub.L. 115-165 exempts custodial parents of minor children and disabled individuals, as well as spouses, from annual payee accountings. Due to the provisions of this law, we expect a drastic reduction in the number of respondents for the form SSA-624-F5 because the majority of the previous respondents fall into one of the exemption categories under this new law.
