

C25. PRINCIPAL INTRODUCTION LETTER TO SCHOOLS (FULL OUTLYING AREAS)

Recently, your school was selected for the Outlying Areas Cost Study (OACS) as part of your district's participation in the study. Mathematica Policy Research and Insight Policy Research are conducting the OACS, a sub-study of the School Nutrition and Meal Cost Study-II (SNMCS-II) for the Food and Nutrition Service (FNS) of the U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA). Cooperation with the study by selected States/Territories, districts, and schools is required under Section 28 of the Richard B. Russell National School Lunch Act.

The study will determine the cost of producing reimbursable meals for the National School Lunch Program and School Breakfast Program, including indirect and local administrative costs. The attached overview provides a summary about the OACS and the data collection activities for certain staff at your school.
