

Will my answers be kept private?

All information gathered for the study will be kept private to the fullest extent allowed by law. No information on individual students or families will be shared or reported. No students or parents will be named or identified in any way. Your participation will not affect any benefits you may receive now or in the future.

What will I be asked?

The person who interviews you may ask about:

- How often your child eats schools meals
- What your child usually eats and what he or she ate on a specific day
- General student characteristics, such as height and weight, and exercise habits
- Satisfaction with the school meal program







How long will the interview take?

The student interview will take place in school. It will last about 60 minutes. The parent interview will take place by phone and will last about (40/25) minutes.

What do I get for participating?

As a thank you for participating, parents will receive a (\$25/\$15) gift card after completing an interview. Students will receive a (\$5/\$15) gift card.
