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## Report Your Fish

All **bluefin tuna** landings and dead discards, and **swordfish** and **billfish** (white and blue marlin, sailfish, and roundscale spearfish) landings must be reported to NOAA Fisheries within 24 hours of the vessel returning from the trip.

- Billfishes and swordfish caught within Florida state waters

Swordfish and billfishes landed in **registered HMS tournaments** must be reported by the tournament operator. Check the list of registered HMS tournaments to be sure that the tournament you are participating in is registered with NOAA Fisheries.

**Maryland and North Carolina** vessel owners should report their **recreational** bluefin tuna, blue marlin, white marlin, roundscale spearfish, sailfish and swordfish landings at state-operated reporting stations and not through this system.
