

## **Form EOIR-29 Appeal from a DHS Officer Decision – Narrative of Proposed Changes**

1. Question 1, page 1, first box, change USCIS to DHS.
2. Question 1, page 1, first box, add the following language in parenthesis following “Officer”: (e.g., Visa Petition (I-130) decision):.
3. Question 1, page 1, second box, delete “permissible DHS bond decision”
4. Question 1, page 1, second box, add “(ii)” after “(A)”.
5. Question 1, page 1, second box, add colon after “waiver decision)”.
6. Question 2, page 1, change “entitled” to “titled”.
7. Question 5, page 1, change “you will be expected to file a written brief or statement” to “and fail to do so the appeal may be summarily dismissed”.
8. Page 1, signature line, add “/Petitioner” to “Appellant”.
9. Form Instructions, ¶ 2. Filing: add “, or U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP)” after “(USCIS)” in first sentence.
10. Form Instructions, ¶ 2. Filing: replace “USCIS” with “DHS” in second and third sentences.
11. Form Instructions, ¶ 2. Filing: delete “USCIS” in fourth sentence.
12. Form Instructions, ¶ 3. Review: replace all occurrences of “USCIS” with “DHS”.
13. Form Instructions, ¶ 3. Review: delete “in” from bullet point 2 in second paragraph.
14. Form Instructions, ¶ 4. Fees: add “If you are filing your form at a USCIS lockbox facility, you have the option to pay for your form filing fees using a credit card. Please see Form G-1450, Authorization for Credit Card Transactions, at <https://www.uscis.gov/g-1450> for more information.”
15. Form Instructions, ¶ 5. Counsel: replace “USCIS” in second sentence with “DHS”.
16. Form Instructions, ¶ 9. Privacy Act Notice: add “s” to “notice” in fourth sentence.
17. Form Instructions, ¶ 9. Privacy Act Notice: delete “or its successors”.
18. Form Instructions, ¶ 9. Privacy Act Notice: add “, or their successors” after “(September 1999).”
19. Revise the date at the bottom of each page to January 2018.
