The information collected will be shared with researchers who sign an agreement with CDC to use the data for research on birth defects or other pregnancy problems and researchers must use appropriate security measures to protect your identity. Records will be covered under the CDC Privacy Act system of records 09-20-0136, Epidemiologic Studies and Surveillance of Disease Problems.
