<p>BLS Occupational Employment and Wages, May 2018: 53-2011 Airline Pilots, Copilots, and Flight Engineers, the mean annual wage is \$169,560 (<a href="https://www.bls.gov/oes/current/oes532011.htm">https://www.bls.gov/oes/current/oes532011.htm</a>). Federal regulations set the maximum work hours and minimum requirements for rest between flights for most pilots. Airline pilots fly an average of 75 hours per month, therefore the hourly mean wage rate is \$188.40 = \$169,560/(75 hours/month x 12 months). The hourly mean wage for this occupation (\$188.40) is also adjusted to reflect the total costs of employee compensation based on the BLS Employer Costs for Employee Compensation Summary, which indicates that wages for civilian workers are 68.3 percent of total compensation (total wage = wage rate/wage % of total compensation).</p>	<p>\$188.40</p>	<p>68.30%</p>
