<p>A series of townhomes (attached single units) that are individually-owned.</p>	<p>If the sampled unit is a rental, return to the Rental Property Description screen and enter “The rental property is composed of a single residential building”. Consider this rental property to have 1 unit.</p>
<p>Part of a duplex, triplex, quadplex, etc.</p>	<p>If the owner owns all of the units and all or some of the units are rented or for-rent, return to the Rental Property Description screen and choose the appropriate response depending on the number of buildings and addresses that compose the property that are under the same first mortgage or are collectively owned as a single entity.</p> <p>If the owner only owns the sampled unit and it is rented or for-rent, return to the Rental Property Description screen and enter “The rental property is composed of a single residential building”.
