## MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD Subj: JUSTIFICATION FOR THE USE OF THE SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER (SSN)

1. What is the purpose of this form?

The NAVCRUIT 1131/238 is required to complete a prospective officer's commissioning package. This form allows recruiters to efficiently identify and authenticate individuals in the U.S. Navy. The name, date of birth and SSN are the only identifiers on the NAVCRUIT 1131/238. There may be multiple individuals with the identical name and date of birth, but SSNs are assigned to only one individual.

2. Why is collection of the SSN necessary?

Per the MILPERSMAN 1000-060 The SSN is the sole military personnel identification number for Navy personnel per Executive Order 9397 (requires federal agencies to use Social Security number as numerical identifier directive) and 10 U.S.C. 5013 (authorizes SECNAV to collect SSN). Since the SSN is essential for personnel identification in the Navy, an applicant must have an SSN prior to being accepted for enlistment or commission in any Navy component. An alternate form of identification and authentication is not available.

3. List the acceptable use criteria for the SSN (found at this link: http://www.doncio.navy.mil/ContentView.aspx?ID=1833)

Geneva Conventions Serial Number: As of the late 1960s, the Social Security number (SSN) has served as the Geneva Conventions serial number for Armed Forces of the United States. Many of the systems, processes and forms used by the Department of Defense categorize individuals by their SSNs. In many cases, it is essential to be able to identify individuals for the purpose of the Geneva Conventions. In addition, it may be necessary to access this number on short notice.

4. If collection of the SSN is no longer necessary and a unique identifier can be substituted for the SSN or the SSN can be eliminated, on what date will either the substitution or elimination occur?

It is paramount to acquire the applicants SSN. This document contains all of the information needed to implement the new Officer Service Record once the individual is commissioned. This is the only time in the commissioning process for Recruiting Command to obtain the candidates SSN which is imperative to establish the individuals pay and IRS account. Without this information there currently is no other method in place to establish a pay or IRS account which will eventually affect the candidates retirement account. Additionally, it is mandatory for all commissioned officers to pass a security clearance and in order to do this the members SSN must be on file and this document is the only vehicle to obtain that information.
