Patient Recruitment and Eligibility Screening Script

START HERE IF RECRUITMENT IS OUTBOUND (Study team receives patient name from referring physician)

Study Team: Hello, my name is [study team member name] from the University of California, San Francisco. May I speak with [name]?

If the Person is not available: Thank the person who answered and say goodbye.

If the Person is available: First confirm that you are speaking to the correct person.

Study Team: I received your name and contact information from Doctor [referring doctor's name] who said you were interested in learning more about this study on using technology for pain management. I'd like to tell you more about this research study, and then ask you a few questions to see if you are interested and eligible to participate in the study. Is this an ok time for you to speak?

If the Person says "No" or "I'm not sure"
