79.7% of office-based physicians in the United States had a certified electronic health records (EHR) system.¹

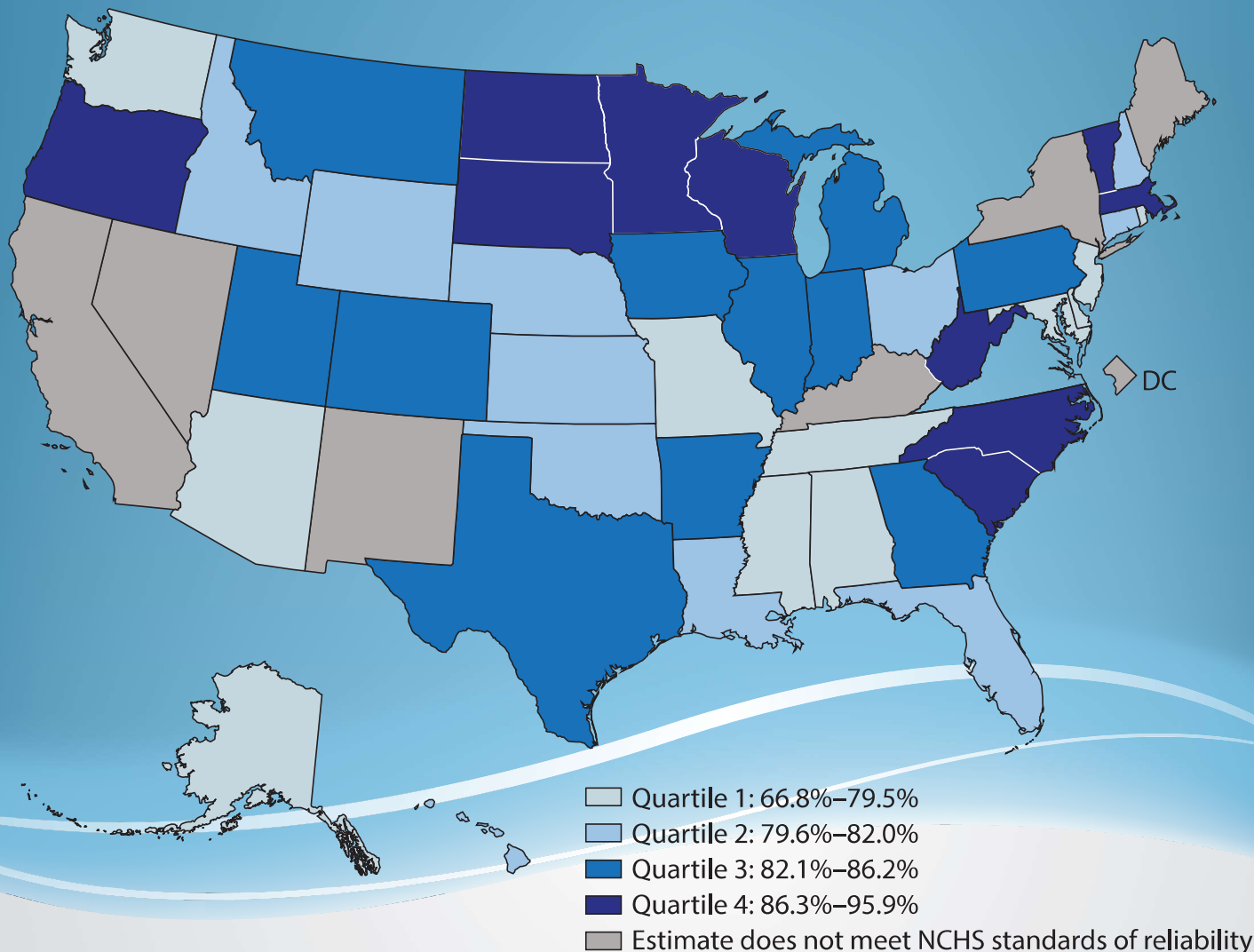


Figure. Percentage of office-based physicians that had a certified electronic health records system, by state: United States, 2017.
