You will also be asked to provide the following:

- 1. **Curriculum Vitae (CV)**: Your CV should include your academic history and research experience as well as any honors, professional experience, publications, and grant applications and awards, if applicable.
- 2. Transcript: A copy of your most recent transcript is required.
- 3. **Three References**: provide reference names, titles, institutions, addresses, and email and phone contact information. iCURE will request letters of recommendation directly from your references.

Note: iCURE strongly encourages applications from underrepresented students and scientists. This information will not be used to determine your eligibility for an iCURE award. iCURE graduate student research experience awards will be for two years. Once selected for iCURE support, iCURE scholars must follow the Graduate Partnerships Program (GPP) Individual Partnership registration and MOU generation process.
